

The Health Sciences program is designed for students seeking a nursing degree (Submit applications to the Admissions office)
 Application for the program must be received by the

 A minimum 2.5 GPA for all completed required academic core courses (courses listed in bold on program info sheets) and minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 at current/last institution.

A minimum composite score of 18 on the National or Residual ACT exam or a minimum score of 58 on the TEAS test. ACT or TEAS scores must be within 3 years of the stated application deadline

BIO 201 and BIO 202 must have been taken within 5 years of the stated application deadline

3 points for 1

1st time nursing student

3 points are awarded for an A, two (2) for a B, and one (1) for a C in ENG 101, MTH 100, BIO 201, and BIO 202

One point each is awarded for completion of each BIO course completed with "B" or higher on first attempt

GPA on required general education courses

All applicable courses must be completed by application deadline in order to be awarded points

All nursing courses must be passed with a minimum of 75 (C) in order to progress in the program.
