



Central Alabama Community College is required to provide regular reporting to the U. S. Department of Education (DOE) on the use of funds authorized by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA). Funds received by Central Alabama Community College under the CARES Act were authorized by Congress and signed into law on December 27, 2020. The information provided below is intended to not only meet the reporting requirements of the CRRSAA Act but also provide information to our college community regarding CACC's use of the student grant portion of the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF).

Central Alabama Community College acknowledges receipt of the supplemental grant funds awarded pursuant to section 314(a)(1) of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) (Pub. L. 116-260) (supplemental award or grant) by the U.S. Department of Education on January 19, 2021. The U.S. DOE provided Central Alabama Community College with an electronically signed Grant Award Notification (GAN) on January 19, 2021.

Students who did not currently have a 2020-2021 FAFSA with a calculated EFC will be provided an opportunity to complete the FAFSA. Degree/certificate seeking students who fail to complete the FAFSA will receive a reduced award upon providing confirmation of U.S. citizenship.

Dual enrollment high school students will be considered for HEERF II funds. Dual enrollment high school students will receive a reduced award upon providing confirmation of U.S. citizenship.

- Dual HS Students, citizenship confirmed - \$233.25

Undeliverable funds will be re-awarded to students with documented exceptional need.

Central Alabama Community College has not distributed any Emergency Financial Aid Grants from CRRSAS (HEERF II) as of March 31, 2021 as the College is still evaluating student eligibility.
